09/30/2003	2	<p><b>Procedure, paragraph 1 and 2:</b> Regional Directors <u>and Facility Administrators</u> are responsible for ensuring the development and maintenance of a plan for responding to tornadoes, fires, earthquakes, ice storms, floods, etc. A written plan must be in place describing response roles and responsibilities. An Emergency Response Coordinator and back-up coordinator shall be named for <u>Central Office</u>, each region, <del>and</del> for each local health department site to coordinate any disaster affecting the site. These same individuals should be responsible for coordinating public health's role in community disasters.*</p> <p>All Local Health Department, <del>and</del> Regional <u>and Central</u> Office staff shall be informed of the necessary procedures for responding to site disasters.</p> <p><b>Change Reason:</b> To add Central Office Personnel in the Disaster Response Policy.</p>
