Employees ...</p> <p>TO:</p> <p>Any employee who has knowledge of a child under 18 years of age who has a physical or mental condition which is, or could be reasonably suspected to be, the result of abuse, neglect, brutality, or sexual abuse is required to report immediately such condition to the <u>(1) the Department of Children's Services (DCS), in a manner specified by DCS, either by contacting a local representative of DCS or by utilizing the DCS centralized intake procedure, where applicable,</u> or <u>(2)</u> to the judge having juvenile jurisdiction in the county, or <u>(3)</u> to the office of the sheriff or <u>(4) to the</u> chief law enforcement officer of the municipality where the child resides.
